**1. C**

We read 'decide in advance'.

**2. F**

We read 'Always put papers in the correct section'.

**3. H**

We read 'Find a quiet place'.

**4. A**

We read 'Begin with your best subject'.

**5. E**

We read 'you have to get it done'.

**6. B**

We read 'he was initially reluctant to talk to me because I was a journalist'.

**7. B**

We read 'despite ... lack of appreciation'.

**8. A**

We read 'he's looking to unwind in front of the television'.

**9. C**

We read 'he calls directory enquiries in Los Angeles, and asks for the home phone numbers of the four assistants on the show'.

**10. B**

We read 'to become a celebrity personal assistant, something he did two months later, was extremely courageous'.

**11. C**

We need a noun after the possessive adjective 'your' and before the preposition 'of'. The meaning of 'intake' is 'amount that your body receives'.

**12. A**

The second half of the phrasal verb 'work out' is after the gap.

**13. F**

The second half of the phrasal verb 'get up' is after the gap. The form of 'walking' later is also a clue, as we use 'try' with the *-ing* form.

**14. E**

The meaning of the missing phrase helps you decide here.

**15. G**

The previous sentence mentions one extreme of being ‘a fitness fanatic’. The missing phrase contrasts with this.

**16. E**

We read ‘lovers of the outdoors will be in their element’.

**17. H**

We read ‘a trip ... takes them down 300 metres’.

**18. A**

Here we mean that ‘the coral reef starts at 7 metres deep and suddenly plunges to a staggering 2000 metres’.

**19. D**

We read ‘not just about the sea’.

**20. G**

We read that ‘the locals are friendly people’.

**21. B**

We read ‘a natural stopping-off point for migrating birds’.

**22. B**

This phrase is used in the meaning of ‘Даже если нет...’.

**23. C**

In the meaning of ‘scarcely’.

**24. C**

Before ‘to’ we can use only ‘owes’.

**25. D**

We have here a phrasal verb ‘to call for – требовать’.

**26. A**

We have a set expression ‘general knowledge – общие знания’.

**27. C**

‘Notice’ is used in the meaning of ‘замечать’.

**28. B**

We have a set expression ‘to work hard – усердно работать’.

**29. C**

‘To give up’ means here ‘давать отростки, ответвления’.

**30. C**

Before ‘from’ we can use only ‘benefits’ in the meaning of ‘извлечь выгоду из’.

**31. B**

‘To regard... as’ means ‘рассматривать, расценивать’.

**32. B**

‘To click’ here means an act of pressing and releasing a button on a mouse.

**33. C**

‘To make up’ means ‘придумывать, сочинять’.

**34. C**

We mean the ancient Greek and Latin languages – the classics.

**35. D**

After the verb ‘to return’ we use the preposition ‘to’ when we mean ‘куда вернулся’.

**36. A**

We are to use here Past Simple Passive.

**37. A**

We are to use here the noun.

**38. B**

Past Continuous is used here, ‘whilst’ helps us to understand it.

**39. D**

After the verb ‘to struggle’ we use the prepositions ‘with’ and ‘against’ when we mean ‘бороться с, против’.

**40. C**

We have here a duration in the past.

**41. A**

In this sentence we use the construction ‘to be known for’ ‘быть известным за...’.

**42. D**

Here we have a main clause of a condition sentence.

**43. C**

We are to use here the adjective in a positive degree.

**44. B**

We are to use here the adjective in a positive degree.

**45. B**

‘To hang on’ means ‘ждать (обычно у телефона)’.
